How to Prepare for Admission to Teacher Education

These steps are required and must be completed in the following order:

- 1. Meet with Student Services (College of Education, Health & Human Service) for an advising appointment.
 - Either schedule an appointment or e-mail an advisor. You can find a list of their staff, including e-mail addresses on their page (http://ehhsstudentservices.utk.edu/academicadvising/).
- 2. Complete the Hearing and Speech screening.
 - The NEXT screening is:
 - August 22 or September 8: 9 AM 12 noon and 2 - 5:00 PM
 - Check-in at the Teacher Education Admissions
 Office, 331 Bailey Education Complex, anytime
 during the specified times <u>and before</u> reporting to
 the Hearing & Speech Center at 1600 Peyton
 Manning Pass. Plan to arrive at the H&S Center no
 later than 11:45 or 4:45 for completion of
 screening.
- 3. Qualified applicants will be contacted via email and provided an electronic link to complete the teacher education application for the admissions board interview.

NOTE: Admission to Teacher Education is a prerequisite for enrollment in Projects Based Instruction (PBI) and Apprentice Teaching (AT).
